

## AfPA welcomes Australia's largest two-year migration intake

## Wednesday 29th March 2023

AfPA's CEO, Carlos Rial, said:

"As an association representing the flexible pavement and wider roadworker industry, we express our full support for the Australian Government's decision to undertake the largest two-year population increase in its history.

"The additional 650,000 migrant intakes this financial year will create opportunities for economic growth and ease the chronic labour shortages in our sector, which has had to lean heavily on international governments to procure talent since 2019.

"We applaud the Albanese government for prioritising population growth as a key factor in the May 9 fiscal package and we recognise the significance of this decision in facilitating economic growth in the long term. However, we also urge the government to place a greater emphasis on vocational training and upskilling of Australian workers to address the existing barriers to workforce participation for local talent. We believe that a holistic approach that balances international migration with domestic upskilling is vital to propel our industry forward and support Australia's growth trajectory."
